

MEDICAL MISSION TO THE WHOLE MAN

From Medical Outreach Missions conducted in Kenya in 2008, 2009, and 2011 we have concluded several important things:

1. Our Mission is to the whole man. We have realized that to be effective we must bring the word of God first to the people as they are waiting for medical treatment.

2. Secondly, we must combine and partner with African doctors and nurses when going into rural areas. In all three cases we joined with The Kijabe Medical Team from Nairobi who obtained the necessary medicines that were effectively administered to the people. When treating patients it was always necessary to have translators when talking with the people.

3. Third, after the medical treatment was given, we found that the people were very receptive to and wanted prayer. Each person was prayed for.

4. Fourth, if possible, funds should be available to give the treated patients bread, beans, corn or some staple food when they leave.

5. Our Medical Missions treated approximately 200-300 or more patients each day. We came to realize that there is a great hunger for medical treatment as most all of the people had never been to a doctor or received prescribed medicine in their life.

6. The field of need is unlimited. We must pray and move by faith to make this ministry known to many U.S. doctors and nurses.

7. It is good to go forth in short term medical mission trips, but it is very apparent that there is a lack of follow-up. To counter this deficiency we must pray and believe God to provide funds for Medical Clinics for sustained effort.

8. Our ministry is called Medical Mission To The Whole Man, which is a Division of World Christian Outreach, Inc. We are now developing our own Website which is coming soon. 9. The foundation scripture underlying everything we do is Matthew 4:23

“And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people”.
